As well as paying rent, you may also be required to make the following permitted payments.

Permitted Payments

Before the tenancy starts (payable to Seddons Lettings 'the Agent')

Holding Deposit: 1 week's rent **Deposit**: 5 week's rent

During the tenancy (payable to the Agent/Landlord)

- Payment of up to £41.67 + VAT (£50 inclusive) if you want to change the tenancy.
- Payment of interest for the late payment of rent at a rate of 3% over the Bank of England Base Rate.
- Payment of costs incurred for replacement or loss of keys/security devices.
- Payment of any unpaid rent or other reasonable costs associated with your early termination of the tenancy.

During the tenancy (payable to the provider) if permitted and applicable

- Utilities; gas, electricity, water
- Communications; telephone and broadband
- Installation of cable/satellite
- Television licence
- Council Tax

Other permitted payments

Any other permitted payments, not included above, under the relevant legislation including contractual damages.
